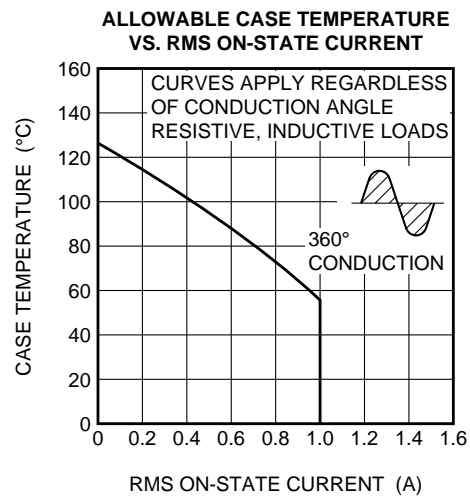
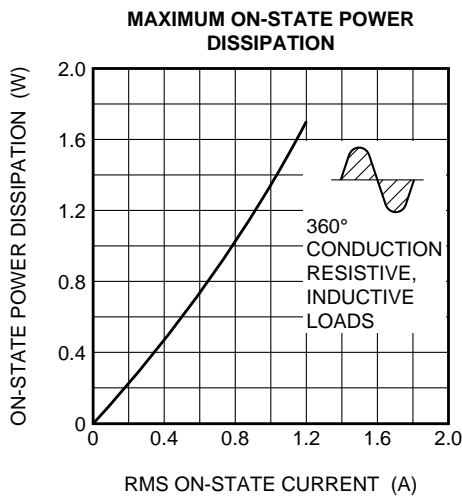
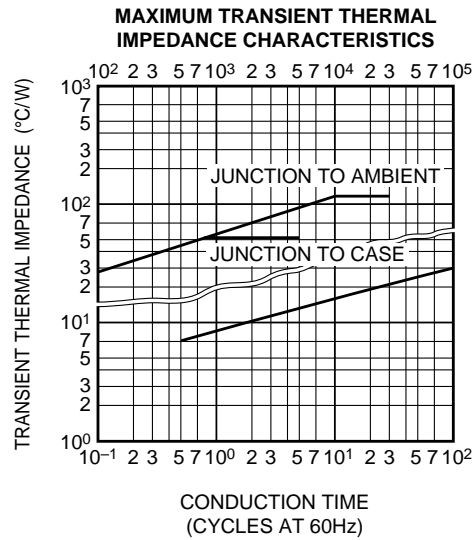
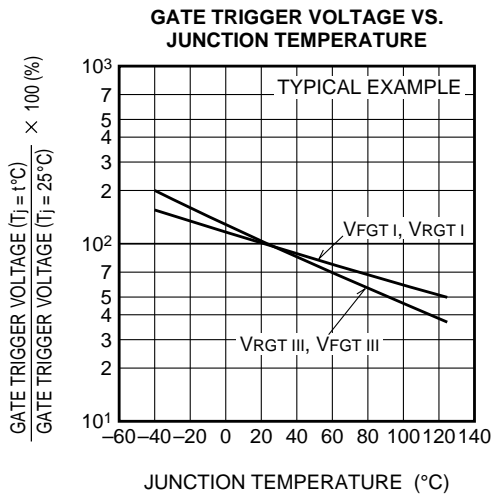
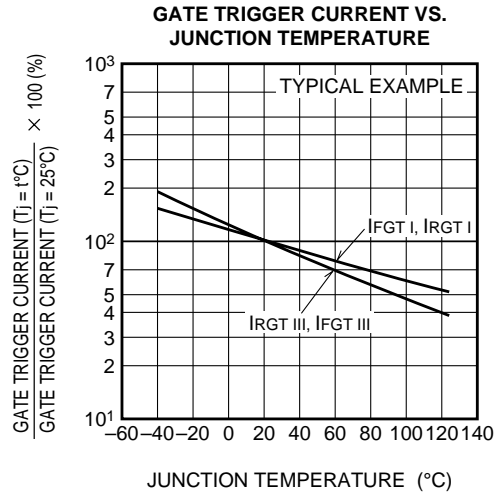
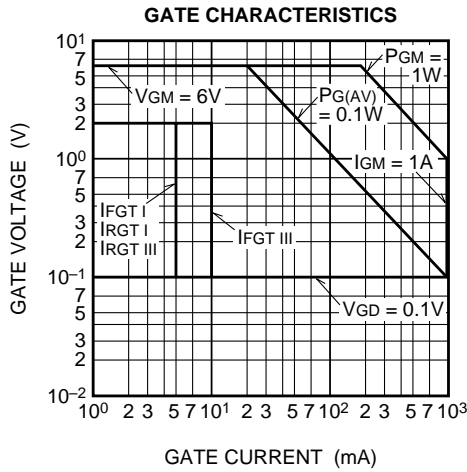


RATED SURGE ON-STATE CURRENT



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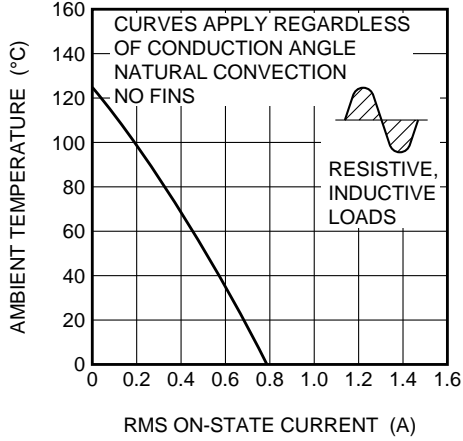
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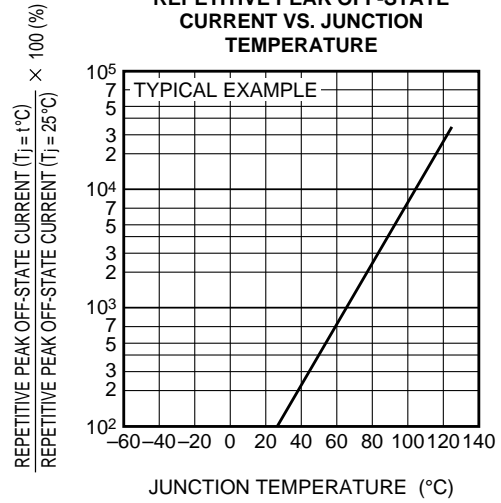
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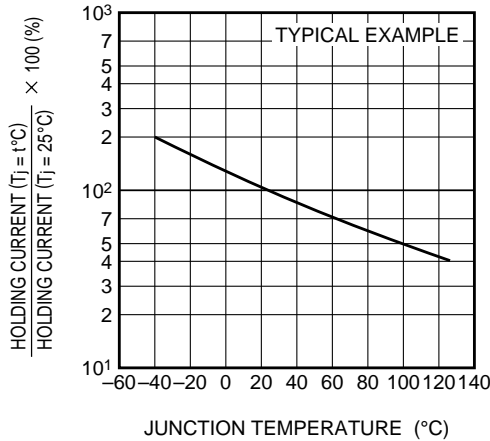
ALLOWABLE AMBIENT TEMPERATURE VS. RMS ON-STATE CURRENT



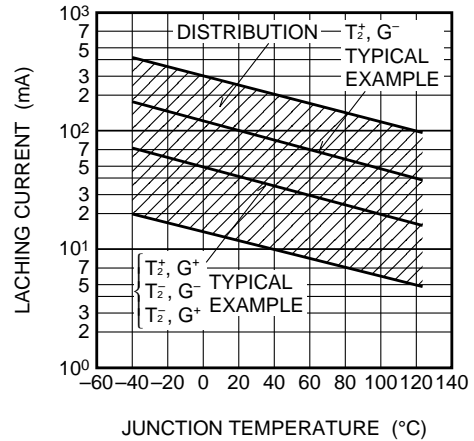
REPETITIVE PEAK OFF-STATE CURRENT VS. JUNCTION TEMPERATURE



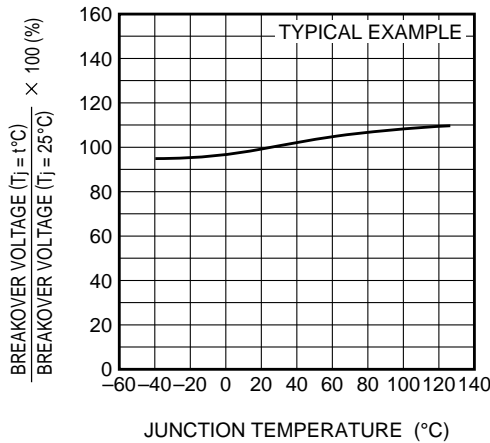
HOLDING CURRENT VS. JUNCTION TEMPERATURE



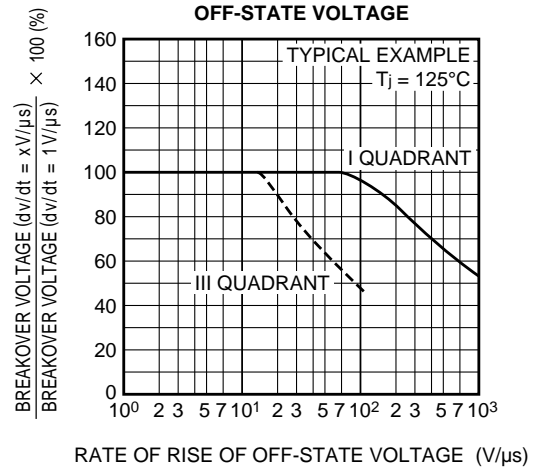
LATCHING CURRENT VS. JUNCTION TEMPERATURE



BREAKOVER VOLTAGE VS. JUNCTION TEMPERATURE

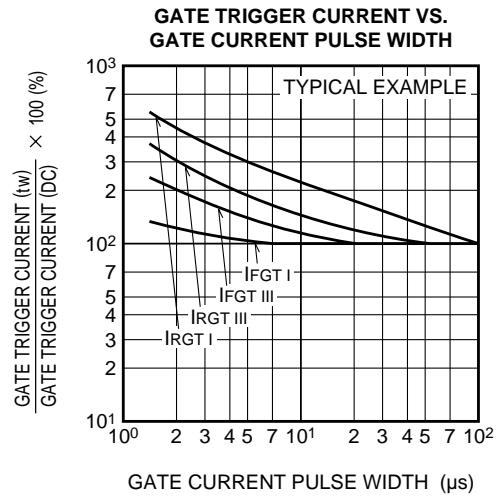
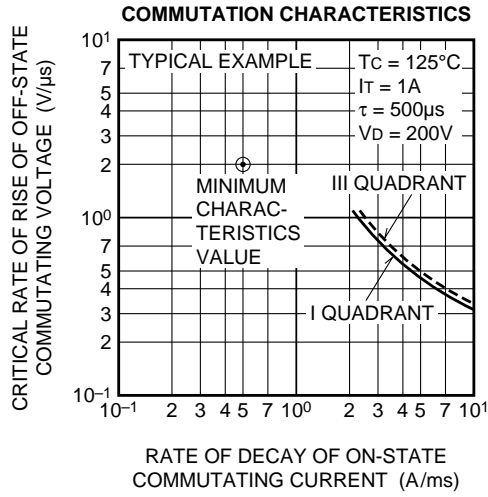


BREAKOVER VOLTAGE VS. RATE OF RISE OF OFF-STATE VOLTAGE
