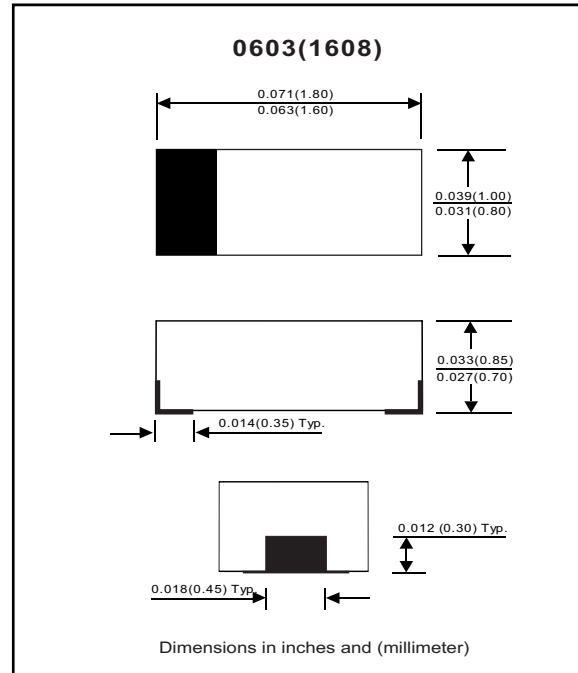


### Features

Fig. 1 - Forward characteristics

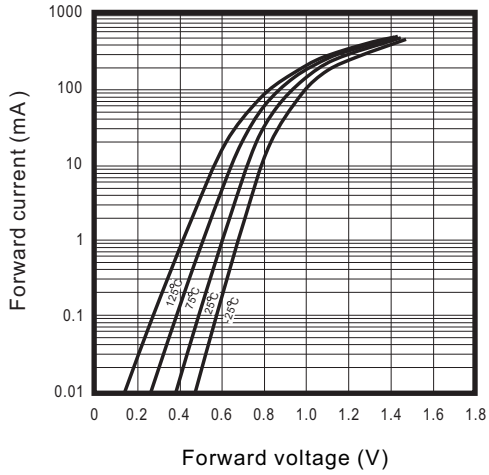


Fig. 2 - Reverse characteristics

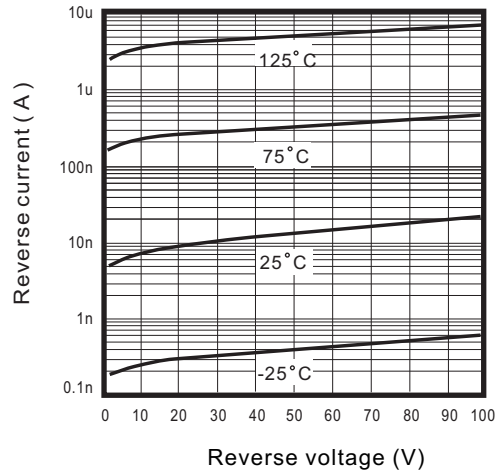


Fig. 3 - Capacitance between terminals characteristics

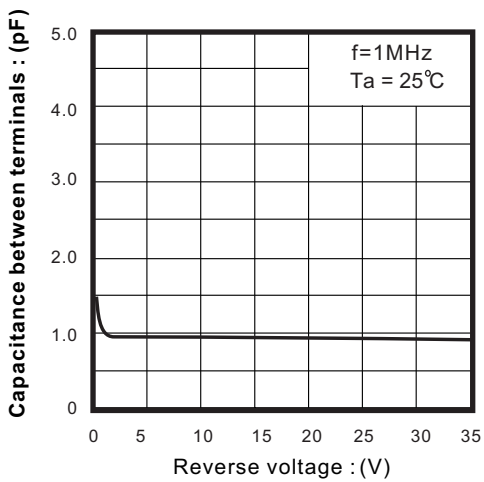


Fig. 4 - Current derating curve
